This Memorandum of Understanding is executed on this 17th day of June, 2022 at Assam Royal Global University, Guwahati, Assam

#### **BETWEEN**

THE ASSAM ROYAL GLOBAL UNIVERSITY, (RGU), a state private University, established by The Assam Royal Global University Act 2013 (to be read with The Assam Private Universities Act 2007), notified by the Government of Assam Gazette on 23/8/2013, herein after referred to as "First Party/RGU", having its campus at Betkuchi, NH-37, Guwahati-781035, Assam. Starting its first academic session from July 2017, RGU currently offers multiple courses in diversified fields of Science, Engineering, Architecture, Humanities and Social Sciences, Pharmaceutical Sciences, etc. Established in July 2009 as Royal Group of Institutions, this institution which has now been upgraded to the level of a university has seen remarkable growth, accompanied by excellent academic results and successful alumni placed in reputed corporate houses.

#### AND

SRI SRI ANIRUDDHADEVA SPORTS UNIVERSITY, (SASU) established by the Government of Assam by an act of the Assam Legislative Assembly (No. LGL. 164/2018/7) in the city of Chabua, Dibrugarh and presently operating from its temporary office on 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of DICC Building, Dibrugarh , Assam , India (hereinafter referred to as "SASU") which expression shall unless the context requires otherwise, mean and include its successors, representatives and permitted assigns of the SECOND PART.

## Article I RECITALS

1. SASU is the first and only sports university established by the Government of Assam by the Act of Assam Legislative Assembly (No. LGL. 164/2018/7) in the city of Chabua, Dibrugarh. The primary focus of the university is on quality education in the area of sport sciences, physical education, and its allied areas. The SASU is temporarily functioning from DU campus since its inception.

#### Article II

#### **PURPOSE**

- 1. Therefore, in the light of the mutually beneficial relations to be formed and of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, which are agreed upon and ratified by the Parties, the parties agree on mutual exchange of the existing facilities of the respective university as:
  - 1. Laboratory
  - 2. Faculty
  - 3. Guest House

#### **Article III**

#### TERMS OF COOPERATION

The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this MoU for cooperation shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both universities before the initiation of that activity. Any such MoUs entered into, as outlined above, will form appendices to this MoU for cooperation.

The two universities hereby agree to use the following resources as per the each other's convenience:

- 1. Laboratory
- Guest House facilities
- 3. Faculty: Exchange of faculties

- 4. Seminars / Conferences / Workshops / Short-term academic programs: These programmes may be jointly organized by the two universities.
- 5. Exchange of academic materials and other information: Information on Research, Research Area, Publications, Adopted Course Contents will be actively exchanged by the universities.
- Joint research activities and publications: Both the universities will conduct joint research activities and publications.
- 7. PhD Guides: Faculty of both the Universities can become the Co-Guide for Ph.D. candidates of each other University if the respective University approves the name of the Faculty as a Co-Guide of the candidate subject to the compliance of the relevant prescribed criteria in the regulations.

#### **Article IV**

## ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- Funds: Both the institutions agree that all specific arrangements and plans for activities are to be negotiated and are dependent on the availability of funds and resources for any activity.
- 2. Collaborative Research: Both the institutions shall undertake collaborative research programmes through multi-disciplinary approach using the infrastructure and other research facilities available in both the institutions.

#### Article V

#### TERM

- Duration: This Memorandum of Understanding will become effective on the final date of signing and will have duration of five years.
- Termination of the Memorandum of Understanding: This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated by either party by providing 30 days written notice to the Coordinators listed below.

- 3. This MoU can only be amended in writing by mutual consent of the two institutions.
- 4. In case the MoU ceases to operate on account of termination thereof, the provisions which require continuance by virtue of this MoU, if applicable, to the extent necessary to secure the objectives of the provisions MoU as agreed upon, may be continued.
- **5.** Any amendment or modification to the present text shall be submitted for review to the competent authorities, and shall not binding unless reduced to writing and signed by both the universities.

#### Governing Law.

This MOU shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of India.

#### 7. Jurisdiction.

This MOU shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Dibrugarh, India.

# Article VI DESIGNATION OF COORDINATORS

 Each party designates the following officials to serve as Coordinators under this Memorandum of Understanding. Individuals designated as Coordinators may be revised by either party by providing written notice to the current Coordinators.

#### **Article VII**

#### General

- a) The Assam Royal Global University and the Sri Sri Aniruddhadeva Sports University may work together to develop a viable and sustainable model for the extension of this collaboration. With approval of the appropriate administrative officials of the respective institutions, the program coordinators may explore the development of funding to carry out this collaboration.
- Each university agrees to comply with the respective guidelines in support of exchanges of faculty.
- c) All activities conducted under this Memorandum of Understanding will be in accordance with all the applicable rules and regulations of both the institutions, and all applicable state and local laws, rules and regulations.

The parties have executed this Memorandum of Understanding on this 17<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2022 at the premises of the Assam Royal Global University, Guwahati, Assam.
